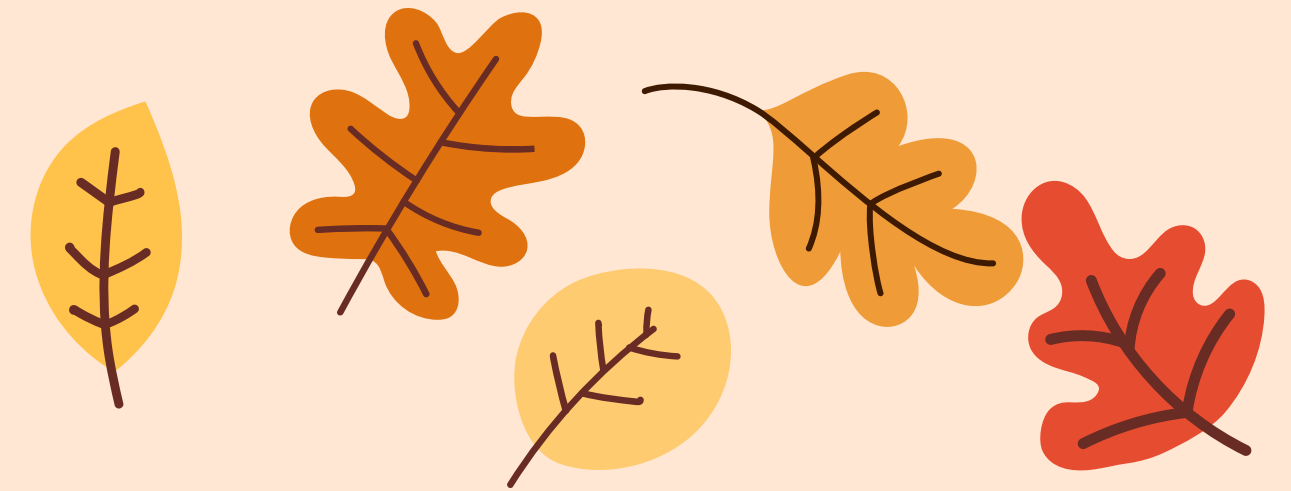


NUMBER BREAKDOWN
